Disaster Planning and Emergency Preparedness Training

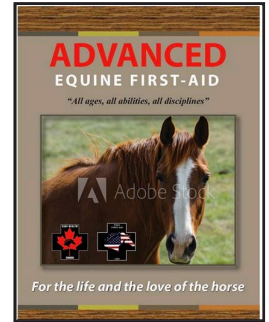

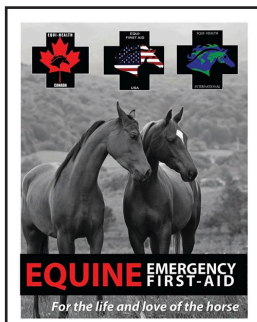

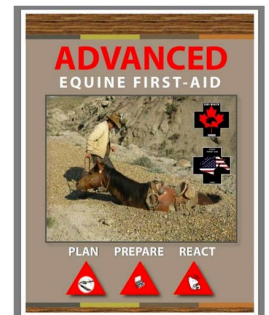

ADVANCED Wilderness & Remote Equine First Aid PLAN PREPARE REACT

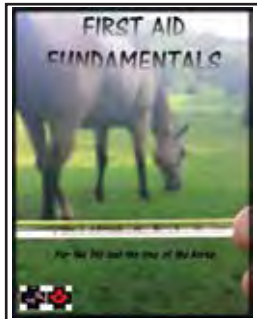

Equine First Aid Fundamentals (ages 10 and up)

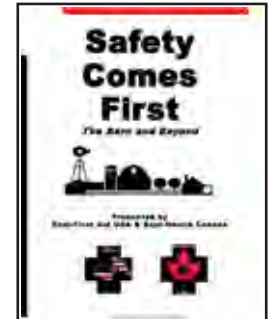

Safe Trailering Practices

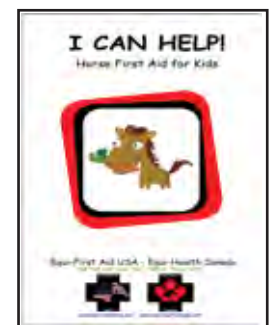
